RE: Police Department Monthly Report  
Town Council Meeting December 11, 2012

During the month of October 2012, there were a total of 505 calls for service in the Town of Dumfries and 418 (83%) of them were handled by the Dumfries Police Department. In addition, Dumfries officers made a total of 223 traffic stops resulting in 113 traffic citations, and 14 criminal arrests. There were 44 parking citations issued.

On Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, Officer Renee Moody was involved in a traffic crash on Fraley Blvd at the south end of Old Triangle Plaza. Officer Moody was transported to Sentara Hospital and released that night. She is currently recuperating at home with no return to work date known. All required paperwork has been completed and submitted.

On November 2<sup>nd</sup>, officers provided a tour of the police station to a local Cub Scout troop. Approximately 30 people attended the tour.

Large voter turnout on Election Day, November 6<sup>th</sup>, resulted in a high volume of traffic entering and exiting Town Hall. Police Department staff provided traffic control and remained on site until the last voter entered the Community Center. Police Department staff cleared Town Hall at approximately 9:45pm.

On November 9<sup>th</sup> and November 16<sup>th</sup> officers took graduates from the 2012 Dumfries Police Department Kids Academy out for pizza and drinks. The children thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to interact with the officers. This continues to be an excellent way for the officers to reach out to our youth and mentor them. We will repeat this in the Spring of 2013.

On November 14<sup>th</sup>, staff attended a Career Fair at ECPI University in Manassas. Quite a large number of students stopped by the police department booth.

On November 16<sup>th</sup>, staff attended the Grand Opening and dedication of the Midwifery and Pediatric Care Center located in Triangle Plaza. Midwifery and Pediatric Care Center Staff were provided police department contact information and services we had available.

On November 18<sup>th</sup>, staff attended the dedication for the new Grace Church building located on Williamstown Blvd. In addition, staff assisted with traffic control at the end of the evening. This was an excellent event and well attended by the community.

During the month of October there was one juvenile arrest made for Domestic Assault.

The Police Department continues to address the goals and objectives it has established for 2012.

Goal 1: Build Stronger Neighborhood and Business Programs with Emphasis on Participation and Cooperation between Citizens and Community Groups.

- During the month of November officers conducted 24.20 hours of foot patrols in the Town.
- During the month of November officers made personal contact with residents and businesses in their assigned communities.
- Officers attended three community events.

Goal 2: Increase the Safety of Motorists and Pedestrians within the Town.

- Officers spent time conducting radar at various locations. This month they maintained high visibility in the area along Fraley Blvd near Canal Street, Main Street, and Fairfax Street. In addition, officers spent time at the intersection of Curtis Drive and Main Street looking for motorists blocking the intersection.

Goal 3: Maintain a professional and effective Police Department responsive to the needs of the Department.


- Officers responded to 83% of the calls for service in the Town.
