RE: Police Department Monthly Report
Town Council Meeting November 1, 2011

During the month of September 2011, there were a total of 398 calls for service in the Town of Dumfries and 296 (74%) of them were handled by the Dumfries Police Department. In addition, Dumfries officers made a total of 137 traffic stops resulting in 50 traffic citations, and made an additional 10 criminal arrests. There were 10 parking citations issued.

On October 18th, the Police Department met with the Williamstown Homeowners Association to discuss quality of life issues affecting the community and the police department's response. This was a very informative and beneficial meeting.

On October 21st, the Police Department made a presentation to the Dumfries Seniors who met at the Community Center. This presentation provided information regarding identifying and avoiding scams as well as personal safety tips. This presentation appeared to be well received by those in attendance.

On October 15th, staff was assigned to assist with a charity walk sponsored by Image Church for the benefit of ACTS. This event was well attended and there were no negative issues brought to our attention.

On October 22nd, the Police Department staffed an information table at the Town's Fall Festival. Officers were able to positively interact with those in attendance and many, many positive comments were received regarding the officers and the police department.
